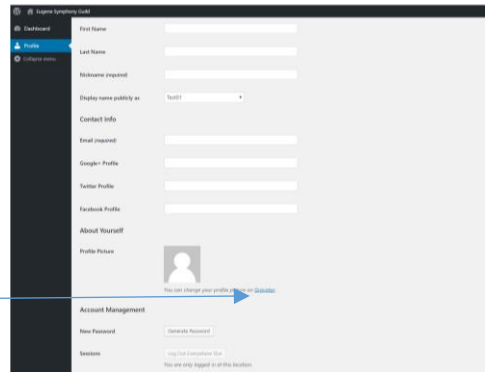


What is a Gravatar?

Your Gravatar (Globally registered avatar) is an image that follows you from site to site appearing beside your name when you do things like comment or post on a blog. An avatar is an image that helps to identify your posts on blogs and web forums.


Should you wish to include a photo of yourself on your ESG Login page, you can do so from your Profile page after you have logged in.

In the About Yourself side menu, Profile Picture, click on *Gravatar* (highlighted in blue) to add a picture.



Follow the instructions on Gravatar's website, <https://en.gravatar.com/> to create an account and upload your photo from your computer.

Once you have completed uploading and saving your photo on Gravatar's website, return to the Profile page and your photo will appear as your Profile Picture and will show each time you sign into the website.

Note: It may take a few minutes before your photo appears. If it doesn't show after a few minutes, try refreshing the Profile page using the  to the left of the address bar.



Note: The location of the refresh button is browser dependent. The one shown is an example using Google Chrome.
