Ogburn Garden

2160 Potter Street, Eugene

Last on Tour in 2011

Asian, English and Mediterranean styles are all featured in this unusual garden. A myriad of potted plants and whimsical statuary are dotted throughout. A lovely rear shade garden, with a winding path leads the visitor through majestic conifers and tree-like rhododendrons, underplanted with shade loving shrubs and perennials.

Robinson Garden

242 South Garden Way

Last on Tour in 2019

This unique 1936 home was built by Gladys Chase Holiday, daughter of the founder of Chase Gardens. The gorgeous, expansive garden, originally hidden by blackberries and ivy, is planted with old and newer shade and flowering trees, along with masses of shrubs, perennials and ornamental grasses – a secluded garden paradise!

Hanes Garden

2783 20th Street, Springfield

Last on Tour in 2017

Disease resistant roses – the owner’s passion – living in “happy comradery” with a fantastic variety of unusual trees, shrubs and perennials, abound in this colorful Springfield garden. Over 200 kinds of plants call this organic garden home, enjoying the deep, rich McKenzie River soil – be sure to stop and “smell the roses”!

Roth Garden

2788 Sorrel Way, Eugene

Last on Tour in 2012

A series of “garden rooms”, connected by fencing, borders and neatly laid out paths, are a feature of this fabulous garden. Look for the lovely perennial border in the back yard area, and don’t miss the huge organic fruit and vegetable garden, with its raised beds, composting area, greenhouse, and new “insectary”.

Eigner Garden

2516 Tandy Turn, Eugene

Last on Tour in 2019

What started out as basically lawn and foundation plantings in 1987, is now transformed to a breathtaking garden, filled with hundreds of dahlias, hydrangeas, roses and perennials. All the annuals that you see are grown from seed by the owner. Recent additions include a salvaged fountain and a new, larger patio.

Hafner Garden

2390 Pioneer Pike, Eugene

Last on Tour in 2014

What used to be square lawns and sharp corners, is now a series of circles and flowing lines in this lovely garden. Look for collections of trumpet lilies, roses, hydrangeas and shade perennials, plus blueberries and many raised vegetable beds. And don’t miss the beautiful ancient Yew that dominates the back lawn.
